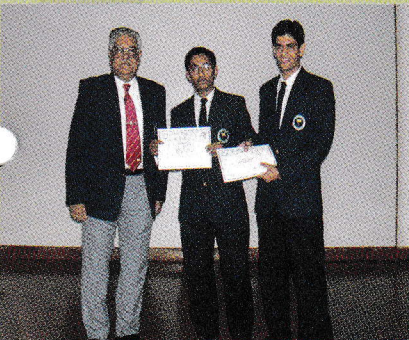
TRANSTECH 07

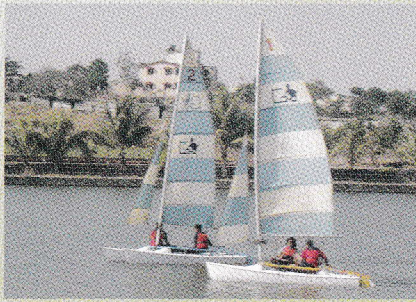

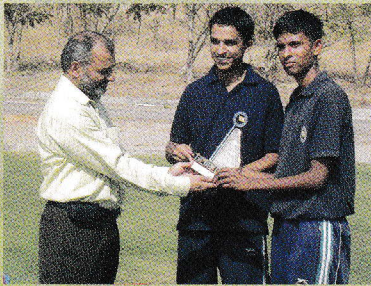


REGATTA
